Council Decisions

Decisions are made by the 9 member ICC Executive Council at meetings held approximately two times yearly over the Council's 4-year mandate. The Presidents of ICC Chukotka, ICC Alaska, ICC Canada and ICC Greenland serve as Vice-Chairs for the Inuit Circumpolar Council. Their Vice-Presidents serve as Council members. A Chair of the Inuit Circumpolar Council is elected by the General Assembly every 4 years.
